WABL Practice Games and Extra Training Sessions Policy

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Overview

Wanneroo Basketball Association (WBA) will strictly adhere to this policy regarding the liability of practice games and extra training sessions for the Western Australia Basketball League (WABL) or State Champs teams.

1. Practice Games

- 1.1. Any practice games must be approved by WBA Management.
 - 1.1.1. Practice games are the responsibility of team coaches to organize.
 - 1.1.2. Referees for practice games against external competition (non-Wolves teams) must be qualified referees.
 - 1.1.2.1. Referees for practice games against internal competition (Wolves teams) do not have to be qualified referees.
- 1.2. Teams are responsible for all court hire expenses if the practice game takes place outside of the WBA allocated practice time.
- 1.3. Teams are responsible for all referee expenses.
- 1.4. The venue for the practice game must meet sufficient safety standards and have a safety plan in place in case of emergency or injury.

2. Extra Training Sessions

- 2.1. Individual teams must seek permission from the WBA to have an extra training session, outside of their WBA allocated practice time.
- 2.2. External or extra training sessions are not sanctioned by the WBA. All participants must be informed that it is not a WBA session, and therefore not covered by WBA insurance. Coaches are responsible for making sure the environment is safe.
- 2.3. Any activity not approved or sanctioned by WBA is not considered an official WBA program activity. Participants should confirm their own insurance and other requirements before participating.
 - 2.3.1. Non- sanctioned training sessions include but are not limited to:
 - 2.3.1.1. Fitness sessions (gym, outdoor, beach, oval)
 - 2.3.1.2. Sessions at external or private facilities
 - 2.3.1.3. Sessions led by guests or external coaches.
- 2.4. Coaches cannot conduct fitness sessions without appropriate qualifications being provided to the WBA staff.
- 2.5. Any external coaches must provide the WBA with a copy of their current Working With Children Check.
